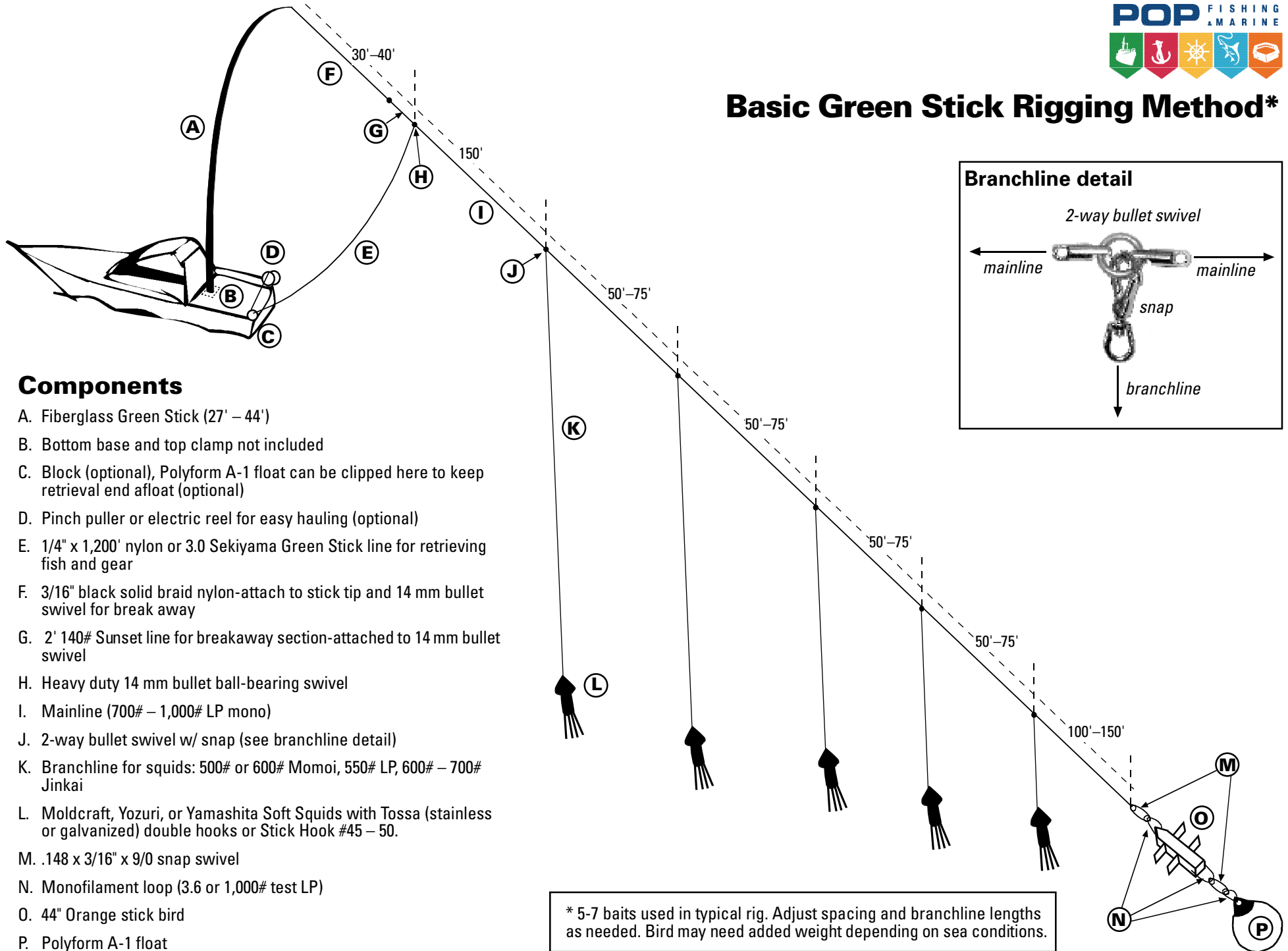


Basic Green Stick Rigging Method*



Components

- A. Fiberglass Green Stick (27' – 44')
- B. Bottom base and top clamp not included
- C. Block (optional), Polyform A-1 float can be clipped here to keep retrieval end afloat (optional)
- D. Pinch puller or electric reel for easy hauling (optional)
- E. 1/4" x 1,200' nylon or 3.0 Sekiyama Green Stick line for retrieving fish and gear
- F. 3/16" black solid braid nylon-attach to stick tip and 14 mm bullet swivel for break away
- G. 2' 140# Sunset line for breakaway section-attached to 14 mm bullet swivel
- H. Heavy duty 14 mm bullet ball-bearing swivel
- I. Mainline (700# – 1,000# LP mono)
- J. 2-way bullet swivel w/ snap (see branchline detail)
- K. Branchline for squids: 500# or 600# Momoi, 550# LP, 600# – 700# Jinkai
- L. Moldcraft, Yozuri, or Yamashita Soft Squids with Tossa (stainless or galvanized) double hooks or Stick Hook #45 – 50.
- M. .148 x 3/16" x 9/0 snap swivel
- N. Monofilament loop (3.6 or 1,000# test LP)
- O. 44" Orange stick bird
- P. Polyform A-1 float

* 5-7 baits used in typical rig. Adjust spacing and branchline lengths as needed. Bird may need added weight depending on sea conditions.
